Summer term, week 6 in Raccoon class...



We are continuing with our focus text The Train Ride.

This week the children will be acting out their favourite part of the story in small groups. They will also be creating a new version of the story, thinking about where their train might take them on it's journey.

During our maths sessions we will be exploring number tracks and considering where numbers are placed within it - are they bigger than 5? Which side of 5 should they be placed then? The children will apply their understanding when playing linear track games with their peers.

Our independent challenges to climb the mountain this week are:

- 1. Order the Train Ride story sequencing cards.
 - 2. Number bonds to 10 on the bus.
- 3. Paint or draw your favorite mode of transport.
 - 4. Design a vehicle using your cutting skills.

We will be reviewing phonics progress this week by completing some assessments of phoneme recall and the segmenting and blending of words.
