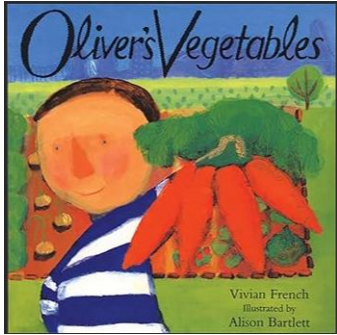




# Welcome back to Early Years...
