

## Science

In Science we are looking at plants, We will be looking at seeds and bulbs, and the types of plants in our local area. We will learn about the parts of a plant and their basic function. We will also be looking at the season of Summer.

## Phonics and spellings

We will be following Little Wandle phonics, re-capping the phase 3 sounds, working on reading, writing and spelling. We will also complete phonic reading sessions.

The children will be learning about families and relationships

## Geography

In our Geography learning we will be looking at the local area, including farms. We will look at types of housing, both on farms and in the village, maps and map symbols. We will also look at the origins of different food types.

## Forest school.

This half term we will explore our school site, identifying flora and fauna living and growing here. We will play games and use natural objects to make pictures and models, linking to our art lessons.

## P.E.

## Literacy

In literacy some of the books we will be looking at are Farmer duck, Where the wild things are, and The 3 billy goats gruff. We will be discussing the characters and the settings, as well as producing our own narratives related to the text. We will also be looking at new vocabulary, sentence formation, the use of capital letters, full stops and spaces.

## Art

In our Art lessons we are learning art and design skills, including printing, colour mixing and exploring different media.

## Maths.

In maths we will be looking at the number system within 20. Recognising amounts, counting on and back. Finding out 1 more and 1 less, recognising number names as words and comparing and grouping objects.

## Music

We will be looking at how pulse, rhythm and pitch work together focusing on a song called 'Hey you'.

## Computing

We are learning about computing systems and networks, and how information technology is used at school and the world around us, including how to stay safe.
