



Week two in Raccoon class...



Our focus text of the week is *The Odd Egg* by Emily Gravett; we have some exciting 'adventure times' planned for Drawing Club across the week. This will provide the children the opportunity for independent sentence writing, remembering capital letters, finger spaces and a full stop.

This week in maths the children will continue to engage with activities that draw attention to the purpose of counting- to find out how many objects there are. Counting skills will be applied as they identify missing numbers within a sequence and consolidate their understanding of the word pattern of number names e.g. teen numbers and '-ty' numbers.

On Friday, the children will begin to explore and compare capacity using the vocabulary 'more than/less than, full/half full/empty'.

Ricky Raccoons need to bring a Forest School kit; even when the weather warms up, the children still need to have their arms and legs covered for safety.

Rosie Raccoons need to bring an OUTDOOR PE kit including trainers/sneakers. Please ensure there are no hoodies.

Tuesday 23rd April at 2pm is our second parents reading café. It really is best if every child has an adult with them to explore the variety of tasks.
