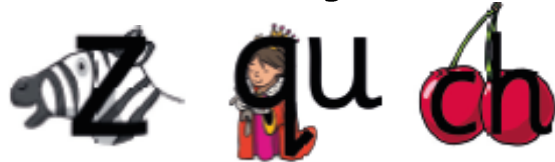


Tuesday is PE day
