



# This week in Early Years...

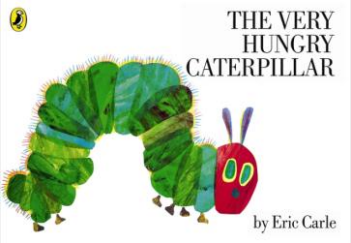

## Maths focus of the week:

Comparison: we will focus on ordinality: considering where numbers to 10 are in relation to each other. Through practical activities and games, we will reason about numbers and think carefully about which is more or less. We will use linear number tracks to play games that encourage us to compare numbers that are far apart, near and next to each other. (For example, 10 is a lot more than 2 but 5 is only 1 more than 4.)
