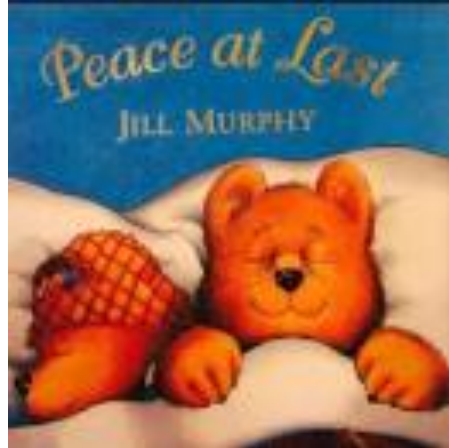

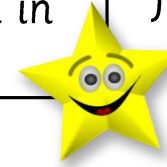
We will focus on our counting skills, practising our 1:1 correspondence skill, by counting numbers at the same time as moving or tagging objects
