Congratulations to **Ruby** for receiving our first resilience star learner award in Friday's assembly.

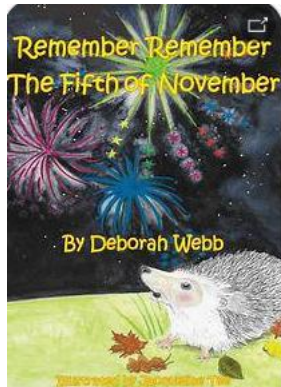
Congratulations to **Koa** for receiving our first resilience star learner award in Friday's assembly.

We will pause to remember and honour all who served on Tuesday at 11am. *Lest we forget.*



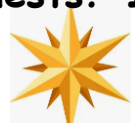
We continue with our daily mile this week. Nearly all children have a pair of shoes to change into now - please ensure you have provided a pair.
