

### Science

In Science we are looking at weather and the seasons. We will be focusing on the season of Winter, and how animals adapt. We will look at ways to measure the different types of weather, and also be looking at day length.

### Phonics and spellings

In our daily Little Wandle phonics will be learning the alternative spelling sounds in phase 5. We will also complete phonics reading sessions. ### History

In our History learning we are finding out about the Monarchy. We will be looking at the role of the monarchy, comparing different monarchy, and ordering them chronologically. Our trip on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> March will also support our history learning.

### English

In English we are moving beyond Drawing Club to Curious Quests! Each week the children will be sent a 'quest' from Ollie the Ocelot to find out something new to share. We will read a new text each week, writing about the character, setting and various imaginative quests! Our books will include; Rapunzel. The Gruffalo's Child, The Snowman, Princess Smarty Pants and non fiction texts about castles to link with our history topic. We will focus on accurate punctuation including question and exclamation marks, and our class target is to use the phonics we know.

### Art

In our art lessons this term we will be explore mixing primary colours to make secondary colours, using paint and various printing materials to support our work.

Our class target is to form our numbers neatly and accurately.
