

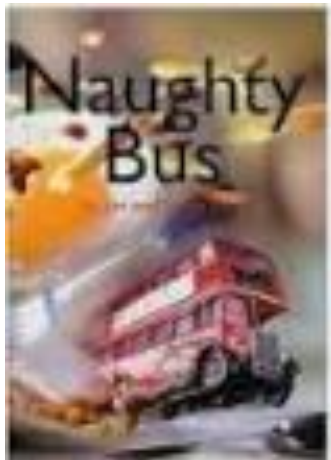


# Early Years Newsletter for Raccoons and Wombats
