

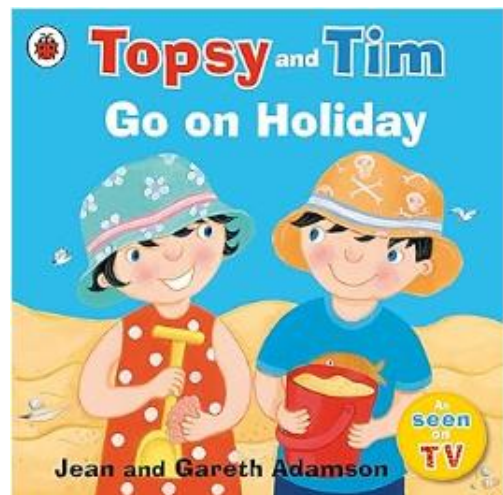


Early Years Newsletter for Raccoons and Wombats

Phonics focus:

We will explore words that end in 's' and sound like 's'; words that end in 's' and sound like 'z'; and we will review words that end in 'es'. Some of the words we will read include: floats sports starts streets crowds groans trains storms crunches dresses screeches splashes speeches scrunches. The tricky words that will be reviewed are put pull full push my by like some come love do.

Maths focus of the week:

Patterns within numbers to 10. This will include making a whole number from two parts; Splitting numbers into 2 equal groups; Recognising that 2 equal groups can make a double number; Understanding that odd numbers cannot be split into 2 equal groups – they are not doubles – they have an odd one out.
