Science

In Science, we are looking at animals and their habitats. The children will establish if something is living, dead or was never alive. They will also work on their scientific skills of observing, collecting data and recording.

Phonics and spellings

We will be following Little Wandle phonics, re-capping the phase 3 sounds, working on reading, writing and spelling. We will also complete phonics reading sessions. Information will come home weekly about spellings and sounds covered. Homework will be due on a Monday.

History

In our History learning, we are finding out about Mary Anning and how her discovery changed history. The children will find out why it was so important at the time in history.

PSHE

The children will be learning how to build relationships.

P.E.

Ocelot PE days are Tuesday (outside) doing key skills, i.e. jumping running, balancing and Thursday (inside) doing dance.

Literacy

In literacy, we will be looking at the book 'Rabbit and Bear'. We will be talking about the characters, predicting what will happen next, creating lists, share ideas, acting out parts of the story and many other things. We will also be looking at sentence formation, the use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Our grammar focus this half term is how to present our work neatly.

<u>Art</u>

In our Art lessons we are learning art and design skills, including mark making; sketching, printing and exploring different media.

Maths.

In maths we will be looking at the number system within 10. Recognising amounts, counting on and back. Finding out 1 more and 1 less, and recognising number names as words. Comparing and grouping objects.

Computing

We are learning about computing systems and networks, and how information technology is used at school and the world around us, including how to stay safe.
