

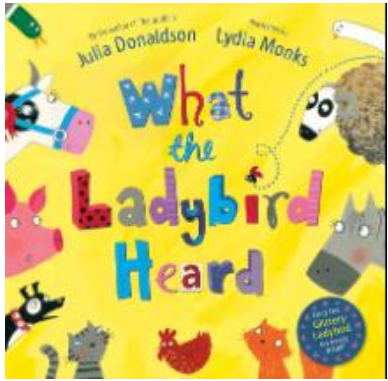

Phonemes of the week:

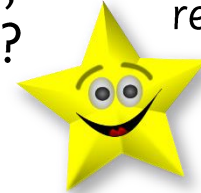


We will be playing oral blending games such as “touch your l-e-g, what sound does a d-u-ck make? N-o-d your head.”
