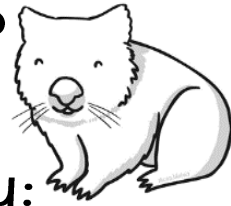




Early Years Newsletter for Raccoons and Wombats

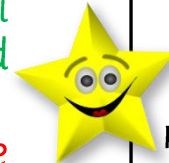
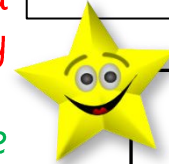
Maths focus of the week:
