

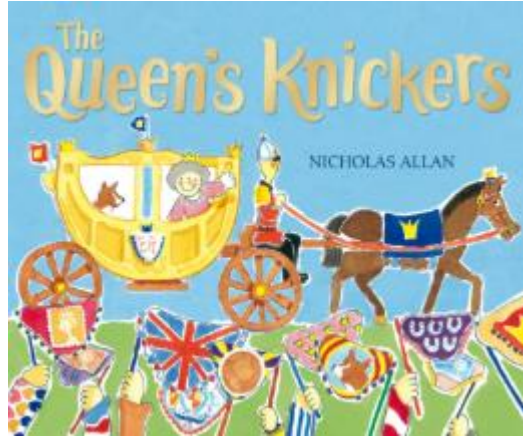


Early Years Newsletter for Raccoons and Wombats

Book of the week:



We continue to focus on longer words. The children will learn that the grapheme 's' can make the sound /z/ within words and at the end of words as a suffix, and that the suffix '-s' and '-es' at the end of words can create plurals. Words to practise at home: vanish lightning earring visit chains poison cheeps surfs wishes foxes fizzes. **Tricky words to review: they all by my are sure pure.** Please continue to practise the recall of the digraphs and trigraphs at home as well.



Maths focus of the week:

Composition: using their previous experience of investigating doubles to begin to practically explore even and odd numbers. Within the context of building Numberblocks characters, they will investigate when a number can be composed of 2 equal parts.
