

Maths focus of the week:

Counting beyond 20 is an important focus this week. English 'teen' number names do not follow a logical pattern; we say 'eleven, twelve, thirteen' instead of 'ten-one, ten-two, ten-three'. It is only when we count beyond 20 that the pattern of our number system begins to become clear. For the children to develop familiarity with the structure and pattern of this system, we need to give them experiences of counting to these larger numbers.
