




This week in Early Years...

Maths focus of the week:

Composition: We will be investigating the numbers within 7; composing and de-composing numbers involves the children investigating part-part-whole relations, e.g. seeing that 7 can be made of 5 and 2.

A key focus will be on partitioning 7 (splitting it into parts) and thinking about the missing part.
