New Little Wandle books will be sent home each Thursday. This will begin Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October.

Our first learning theme is 'On the Farm'. We will be exploring story books with a farm and growing theme and there will be farm enhancements in our classroom for us to enjoy and explore. We are also hoping for some farm animals to come and visit us at school!
