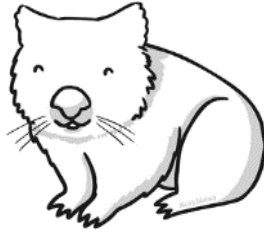


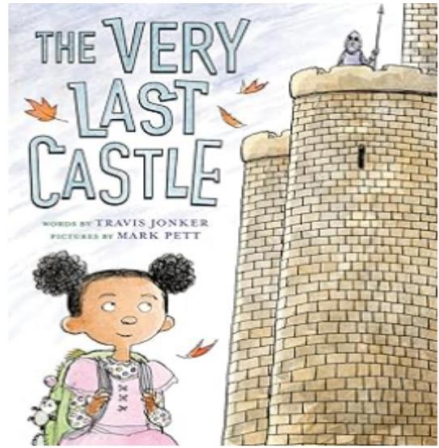

Book of the week:



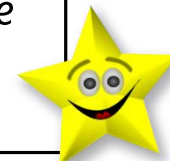
